Health & Safety Services FAQ's

Why should I learn lifesaving skills?

Would you know what to do in these common emergencies: cardiac arrest, choking, shock, an allergic reaction? Responding quickly and properly can save the life of a spouse, child, friend, or stranger.

How do I register for a course?

You can register in person, by mail, or by telephone at 989-754-8181. Payment is due upon registration. Employers may register their employees with a company credit card or check. **All required materials included unless noted.**

Do you accept credit cards?

Yes, we accept Visa and MasterCard.

What is your cancellation and refund policy?

A refund will be issued, less a \$10 processing fee, for cancellations made at least 48 hours prior to the course. Cancellations made after the 48 hour period will not be refunded but one rescheduling will be allowed. We reserve the right to cancel classes due to insufficient registration, instructor unavailability, or inclement weather.

Are there any physical restrictions?

Certification requires a skills ability demonstration on the floor. Please wear practical clothing. Certificates of attendance may be issued for those that successfully complete all other portions.

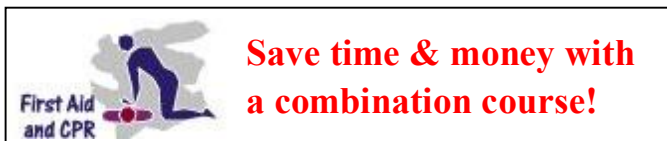
